This is a wonderfully well bred calf and should make a real sire of good type and production.

Look at the great records, and the famous sires! Every side of his pedigree just glitters with the most famous production and transmitting blood of the breed.

The dam is by the greatest sire of 30,000 lb milk producers that ever lived, Carnation Segis Prospect, and he is a son of the only cow to produce 37381 lb of milk in a year.
